- 248.3 SIT *When God Doesn't Answer Your Prayer* by Jerry Sittser. The author "provides insights to keep you praying with greater faith and deeper hope." Includes group discussion questions at the end of the book.
- 248.8 KIM *Grace-based Parenting* by Dr. Tim Kimmel. This book "is not another manual full of impossible standards; rather it is a new map for learning to see ourselves and our children through God's limitless tenderness—to raise our kids the way God raises us." Includes study questions.
- 248.8 KIM *Why Christian Kids Rebel* by Dr. Tim Kimmel. In this book, Dr. Kimmel "provides help for building bridges to wayward children. And...offers a doable plan for parents of young children who want to avoid having them walk away from God in a few short years." Includes discussion questions.
- 275.1 YUN *The Heavenly Man: the remarkable true story of Chinese Christian Brother YUN.* "This is the intensely dramatic story of how God took a young half-starved boy from a poor village in Henan Province and used him mightily to preach the gospel despite horrific opposition.
- 277.3 CAL *The House Where the Hardest Things Happened* by Kate Young Caley. In this "memoir about belonging", the author, "recounts the hurt and confusion she felt as a young girl, her subsequent questions concerning the Church, and her thoughtful and determined journey back to God."
- 277.3 SLA *Lost & Found: one daughter's story of amazing grace* by Kathryn Slattery. This memoir "is a beautifully told and heartfelt journey through the pains of growing up and the trials of growing old."
- 289.7 JAN *Growing Up in Turbulent Times: memoirs of Soviet Oppression, refugee life in Germany and immigrant adjustment to Canada* by Waldemar Janzen (retired CMU Professor Emeritus).
- 813.54 TEN *The Hadassah Covenant* by Tommey Tenney & Mark Andrew Olsen. "This sequel to Hadassah Parallels the lives of Hadassah and Queen Esther in modern-day Israel and the Persian kingdom. Each woman must remain strong as she fights for her people."
